Our apprenticeships offer an immersive “earn while you learn” training and coursework experience to prepare students for success in a professional role upon program completion.

Apprenticeship - Medical Assistants - Apply Now!

Medical Assistants (MAs) work with nurses and providers performing both administrative and clinical duties. A typical day may include greeting patients, rooming patients, answering phones, and assisting with coding or billing insurance forms. MAs also perform tasks like documenting patient medical histories, assisting with exams/procedures and coordinating medical tests.

Our six-month MA Apprenticeship offers hands-on and classroom training to prepare you for the Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) test through the National Healthcareer Association. Apprentices will be hired by Centura Health while completing their Medical Assistant training through Arapahoe Community College.

Apprenticeship - Sterile Processing Technicians - Apply Now!

Sterile Processing Technicians sterilize and assemble equipment for medical and surgical procedures, as well as track inventory and order supplies. Our year-long sterile processing apprenticeship is offered in partnership with Front Range Community College (FRCC) and qualifies for you for an opportunity to join an SPT at locations across our system.

The program consists of one coursework semester that includes both didactic and hands-on simulation in a fully-functioning sterile processing department. Apprentices learn how to process surgical instruments used in an operating room setting to comply with standards set by the International Association of Healthcare Central Service Material Management (IAHCSMM) organization.

Apprenticeship - Pharmacy Technicians - Apply Now!

Pharmacy Technicians are allied health professionals who assist Pharmacists in promoting an organized and functional pharmacy service. They also prepare medications for dispensing and maintain records.

Our Pharmacy Technician training is a paid, six-month program that prepares students to take the Certified Pharmacy Technician test through the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board. Apprentices will be hired by Centura Health while completing a Pharmacy Technician training through Front Range Community College (FRCC).
